Bylaws

for

ELECTION OF EXECUTIVE OFFICERS

And

DELEGATES & ALTERNATES TO CONVENTIONS

And

STANDING COMMITTEES

1. Election of Executive Officers and delegates and alternates to Conventions and Standing Committees shall be by secret ballot and under the supervision of the Election Committee.
2. No member shall be eligible for election to the Executive Board until member has been in continuous good standing in the Local Union for one year, immediately prior to the day of nomination.
3. All members of Local 200 stand nominated.
4. No member can be nominated for more than one Executive office.
5. Each voter will be required to have a valid union card in order to obtain and sign for a ballot, and after receiving ballot, member's union card shall be punched.
6. If a member wishes to vote, but has no valid identification as required by the election rules, or if a voter is challenged as ineligible at the polling place, a ballot shall be issued. After voting, challenged ballot shall be placed in a blank envelope, and the sealed blank envelope shall be placed in a large envelope. Voter's name and Social Insurance Number to be marked on large envelope and put in ballot box.
7. Only the D.R.O. will witness the mark of any voter unable to read or write. Each D.R.O. will make the final decisions and have the right to appoint an alternate.
8. Any one disrupting election or count will be forced to leave the poll or room permanently.
9. Any member of the Election Committee accepting nomination for any office shall automatically cease to be a member of said committee and shall be replaced for this election and any business pertaining to it.
10. Candidate shall have the right to submit her/his commonly known name in writing to the Election Committee Chairperson as she/he desires it to appear on the ballot and it shall so appear. If not notified, the Committee will use name, which appears on file in Local Union Office.
11. Ballots must be marked on the premises provided. Ballot taken from the premises will be disqualified.

12. No lobbying or canvassing for votes shall take place on the premises of the polling booths. Candidates violating this rule will be disqualified.
13. The Election Committee shall conduct the counting of ballots and shall announce the final results.
14. Each candidate shall have the right, at her/his own expense, to have one challenger at each booth, who shall be an accredited representative, present when votes are cast and a challenger present when they are being tabulated and said challenger must be a member of Unifor Local 200, Candidates cannot be challengers. Challengers are subject to Election Committee By-laws.
15. (a) Election of all local union Executive Officers shall require a majority of the votes cast for the office. When more than two candidates stand for election and no one receives a clear majority, a run-off election shall be held of the two candidates with the highest number of votes.

(b) Election of delegates for Conventions and Standing Committees shall require a simple majority.

(c) In the event of ties for Conventions and Standing Committees, the Election Committee shall have the right to break all ties.
16. Ballot boxes will be kept at Local 200 under lock and key. Such key to be held by the President of the Local.

Note: Election workers are requested to sit a reasonable distance from the polls.
